Directions: On I-40 westbound from Albuquerque take Exit 149 north. Go 4.3 miles on

Atrisco Vista then turn west onto Shooting Range Access Road for 3.7 miles. Follow Albuquerque Shooting Range Park signs. OR on I-25 southbound from Santa Fe take Exit 232 (Paseo del Norte) and drive west for 7.3 miles. The road makes a 90° turn to the left (south) and becomes Atrisco Vista. Drive south 3.3 miles and turn right (west) onto Shooting Range Access Road for 3.7 miles. Follow Albuquerque Shooting Range Park

Time: Registration Begins at 8:00 AM and firing begins at 9:00 AM. If you can arrive early to

assist with setting up targets and tables, your help will be appreciated.

Registration: Sign in at the Sandia Gun Club Storage Shed at 8:00 AM and pay match/access fees. The

one-time league fee is separate from the access fee. The access fee will be paid each month that you compete. The league secretary will collect all league and range fees. The secretary will pay the range office. Matches are normally fired on the NRA Bullseye 100-point range located west of the range office. This registration process is subject to change based on SRP

protocols.

Fees: One-time league fees are \$20.00. Checks made out to SANDIA GUN CLUB are preferable.

Rules: NRA Conventional Outdoor Pistol Rules will apply.

Targets: B6 (50 yard) B-16 and B-8 (25 yard). Competitors furnish staple guns and staples.

Classifications: NRA Classifications will apply. Unclassified competitors compete in the Master class.

Temporary score books will be made available for those who need them.

Equipment: .22 Pistol or Revolver. .32 to .45 caliber center-fire pistol or revolver

Course of Fire: 90 shot course of fire with each gun, .22 and centerfire. A competitor may choose to only

Shoot one course of fire or 22 only. Scores are added together for the aggregate. 20 shots Slow Fire – 30 shots National Match Course – 20 shots timed fire – 20 shots rapid fire

Awards: Due to rising costs of liability insurance there will be no awards.
